

Probable Cause Affidavit

I, Detective J.F. Taylor have been a law enforcement officer with the Raleigh Police Department for eighteen years. I am currently assigned to the Major Crimes Task Force in the Detective Division of the Raleigh Police Department. During my experience as a law enforcement officer, I have investigated and or assisted in the investigation of numerous homicides. I have received specialized training through the Raleigh Police Department and the North Carolina Justice Academy dealing with laws of arrest, search and seizure, criminal investigations and preparation of search warrants.

On 11/08/05 at 0222 hrs the Raleigh Police Department responded to a reported Rape and Stabbing at 3010 Apartment A Walnut Creek Parkway. When officers arrived they found the victim, Lauren Redman deceased in the breezeway of the building. The victim had been stabbed multiple times. Detectives with the Major Crimes Task Force responded and began an investigation. Prior to her death the victim was able to give a brief description of the suspects and indicated that it was two black males.

During the investigation it was learned that Byron Waring and Joseph Sanderlin had been at the victim's apartment just before the crime was reported on 11/8/2005. Mr. Waring was located at 5120- A Vann St. Waring voluntarily came to the police department for an interview. Joseph Sanderlin was found to be hiding in the residence at 5120- A Vann Street. He was located during the execution of a search warrant at that address. Sanderlin was arrested on an outstanding warrant and transported to the Raleigh Police Department.

During the interview with Byron Waring he was asked to allow investigators to examine his shoes. Detective's located blood drops on the top of one of Waring's shoes. Investigators also conducted an area search around 5120-A Vann Street and located an item belonging to the victim, Lauren Redman. The item was located in the same area that Waring had been standing


